



Bicycle Transport Regulations

Bike Park Monte de São Marcos

Article 1 – Subject Matter

This regulation defines the conditions of access, use and safety of the bicycle transport system operated by Bike Park Monte de São Marcos.

Article 2 – Transportation Tickets

1. Access to transportation is exclusively for holders of a confirmation ticket from Bike Park Monte de São Marcos.
2. The travel pass is personal and non-transferable.

Article 3 – Opening Hours and Operation

1. The transportation service operates from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM, with a lunch break between 1 pm and 2 pm, unless otherwise indicated by the Organization.
2. Transportation will only be provided upon prior registration and confirmation.
3. Transportation will only be provided for groups of at least 4 athletes or upon payment of the equivalent fee for each athlete.
4. Only vehicles previously authorized by Bike Park Monte de São Marcos are allowed to provide transportation.
5. Transportation will be provided by local associations that organize the events.
6. Reservations will only be validated after confirmation from Bike Park Monte de São Marcos.

Article 4 – Boarding and Safety Rules

1. The athlete is required to place the bicycle in the vehicle designated for this purpose.
2. Athletes must wait their turn in an orderly fashion, respecting the waiting lines.
3. It is strictly forbidden to get on or off the transport vehicle while it is in motion.

Article 5 – Liability and Damages



1. Bike Park Monte de São Marcos is not responsible for damage caused to bicycles during transport, resulting from the previous condition of the equipment or improper securing by the athlete.
2. Each athlete is responsible for ensuring their bicycle is properly stored..

Article 6 – User Conduct

Inside transport vehicles, the following is prohibited:

- a) Adopting behaviors that jeopardize the safety of the driver or other road users;
- b) Transporting sharp or dangerous objects.

Article 7 – Sanctions

1. Disrespect for the rules of this regulation or for the instructions of the staff may result in...immediate cancellation of the pass. No refunds will be given for use, and in serious cases, expulsion from the Bike Park Monte de São Marcos.
2. During the competition, any disregard for the rules of these regulations may lead the organization to cancel the athlete's registration without any type of refund.
